August 15 (Wednesday): Deadline for entry forms and fees.

All paperwork to be in by this date. **NOTE:** *Work will not be accepted if paperwork arrives later with artwork.*

Miniature Art & Photography must be shipped separately from entry form & fees. August 20 Monday 9am-4pm, August 21 Tuesday by Noon). Final Days for accepting Art & Photography entries hand delivered or shipped.

August 22 (Noon): Judging

August 22: Members' Preview Gala. Reception is by invitation only for artists, photographers, judges, WRVAG members and their guests. 5pm- 7pm.

August 23-28 Open Daily-9am-4pm

August 29 (Wednesday): Open 9am-noon Show closes at Noon.

Art & Photography may be picked up from 12:00 pm to 4:00pm **ONLY!**

PICKING UP Art & Photography

Check-out August 29 Noon to 4 PM **ONLY!**

Artists & Photographers and individuals who have purchased Art & photography may retrieve their pieces at these times. Art & Photography picked up by persons other than the owner will be released only on presentation of written permission. Work not picked up will be stored by WRVAG until the owner takes possession. Storage fees may apply after 30 days. **DO NOT REQUEST EARLY PICK UP.**

ADMISSION is free to current WRVAG members. Admission for non -members is \$2.00 for adults or \$5.00 per family.

Ribbon Awards:

In addition to the Cash Awards above, ribbons will be awarded in professional, amateur, and youth classifications for first, second, and third places in each category. Cash Awards for first, second and third will be given depending on number of entries in show.

Popular Award:

A special rainbow-colored ribbon will be given for the most popular work in each category chosen by the votes of the viewing public.

CONDITIONS

All art work & photography must be original. **Any work which is recognized as a copy will NOT be hung for exhibition.**

Entries must be on exhibit until the show closes. Artists & Photographers who desire to insure their work are responsible for making their own arrangements. WRVAG is not responsible in case of loss or damage.

Entries previously entered in the WRVAG National Shows are not eligible. Substitutions of work or price changes will not be permitted after the entry form is received. The show committee &/or judge will make the final decisions on questionable entries and their eligibility. Due to the variety of age groups that attend this show, WRVAG Board reserves the right to refuse entry of any work deemed inappropriate for young viewers. **ENTRY CLASSIFICATIONS**
Professional: Artists & Photographers who earn a significant portion of their income from the sale of their work. Also, anyone who has been juried into a national show or organization.

Amateur: Artist & Photographers who do not earn significant portion of their income from the sale of their work.

Youth: Two Divisions: Ages 11 years and under; Ages 12 - 17 years old.

MEDIA CATEGORIES- Photography

Professional: Black & White and Color.

Amateur: Black & White and Color.

Computer-Generated Work. - Must be of your own original photography.

MEDIA CATEGORIES-

Miniatures Art Work Maximum of 80 square inches, excluding the frame, frames on miniatures may not exceed 3 inches wide. Must be matted. Professional & Amateur & Youth.

Medium: Oil, Watercolor, Pastels, Graphic, Acrylic, Mixed Medium, Sculpture

(Note- Restrictions of size of Miniatures does not apply to Photography.)

ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Entries are limited to five (5) pieces of work. The entry fee varies depending upon whether you are a 2018 WRVAG member. **See Entry Form & Labels.** Please check and complete the membership information included on the entry form.

Please print or type. ***All exhibit entries must have a title.*** **No Exceptions!** "Untitled #1" is not an acceptable title. **Do not send slides of artwork with your entry form. This show is not pre-juried.** Your completed entry form must arrive **by August 15 (Wednesday) 2018.** Send completed entry form and fees to:

FRAMING INFORMATION

All work must be sturdily framed with 2 screw eyes or 2 D-Ring hangers with *wire* in place, suitable to be hung on a panel. Absolutely no Foam Fast hangers, single D-Ring hangers, Saw-tooth hangers or Swiss corner clips. In addition, make sure there are no sharp objects (nails, screws, etc.) protruding from the work. Your work will be returned, and not included in the show, if it is not received in proper condition for hanging. **Your entry fee will not be refunded.** **Gallery Wrapped will be allowed.**

SALES

All Professional and Amateur entries must be for sale. Youth may have work that is not for sale, please mark it "NFS". Work sold during the show may not be removed from the show until 12:00pm August 29, 2018 **unless purchased by out of county buyers.** It will be released to save shipping/handling costs for buyers. WRVAG will handle all sales of work at the show; a 25% commission will be retained on all sales.

SHIPPING INFORMATION

Work may be shipped by UPS, US Postal Service or FedEx. We suggest you use strong reusable crates or cartons which conform to the regulations of your chosen carrier.

Packing peanuts are not acceptable! Please do not use when shipping Art and photography!

Please determine the cost for return shipping to your address, insured for the desired amount and using your same carrier. Include return shipping label or sufficient funds with the entry form to cover the cost of returning your work. If return shipping funds are not provided, work will be kept by the WRVAG until funds are provided. Storage fees may apply. **Please add US \$12.00 per crate/box for handling in addition to your actual return shipping costs.** The handling fee is for shipped artwork only. Storage fees may apply after 30 days.
