

2018 SOUP & BREAD CONTEST RULES, SET-UP & GUIDELINES

****Bring/send the following to the Headwaters Center by Monday, February 19, 2018**

- completed entry form
- \$10 for EACH soup and/or bread you enter
 - cash or checks made payable to Headwaters Center

Date & Time: Contest will be held at the Headwaters on February 24, 2018 from 5:30 till 7 p.m.

Items Provided: 2oz. serving cups, spoons, napkins

General Rules: SOUP (for each entry)

- make about 3 gallons of soup (there are 128 oz. in a gallon) ahead of time
 - enough for about 250-300 tasters each receiving a 2oz. serving
- bring it to the Headwaters in a crock pot or container that keeps the soup at a constant heat of 135°
- provide a list of ingredients (to address allergy issues)
- bring 2 oz. serving ladle
- bring extension cord and/or power strip
- have soup & bread ready to judge at the Headwaters by 4:30 p.m.

BREAD

- make enough so each voter/taster can have a minimum of one large bite
- provide a list of ingredients (to address allergy issues)
- serve individual portions on napkin (provided)
- have each bread ready to judge at the Headwaters by 4:30 p.m.

Set-up: Set-up will begin at 3:00 pm at the Headwaters

- bare tables will be provided with room for up to two contestants per table
- you are allowed to decorate your space

Judging: Pre-selected judges will conduct a 'blind' evaluation of each entry

- judges will select 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for soup and 1st, 2nd and 3rd for bread
 - cash awards will be \$100 for 1st, \$75 for 2nd and \$50 for 3rd in each category
 - winners will be announced around 7:00 p.m.

People's Choice: One bread & one soup "PEOPLE'S CHOICE" winners will be chosen

- each voter/taster will be offered a ballot when he/she pays the \$5 Soupenanny admission fee, and signs the release form
 - taster ballots will include the name of the cook/baker, the name of the soup or bread, and a box to check for their choice
- ballots will be counted by designated representatives and winners will be announced around 7:00 p.m.

****In the event of a tie, entries will be judged again by a selected public panel of judges.****
